

Northwest Tri-County Intermediate Unit Act 89 – Nonpublic School Services

English and mathematics tutoring services are provided to the nonpublic schools by the Northwest Tri-County Intermediate Unit #5 through state funding provided via the Act 89 Program. All Services provided free of charge on school premises.

Your child may be referred to our program by his classroom teacher as a student who may benefit from auxiliary tutoring services. In addition, a student may seek extra help on his own.

Tutoring sessions are generally scheduled on a weekly basis. These sessions include reviewing class material, working on homework, and preparing for class tests. No extra homework is assigned and there are no exams given.

We will be working closely with your son's teacher in helping him accomplish the course requirements. Please know that your son's classroom teacher will be made aware of the extra effort that he is making. Your son must arrive for his tutoring sessions prepared and ready to work each time he attends.
