Villa Maria Academy and the Cathedral Preparatory School Scholarship

To be eligible for the financial aid, you must meet the following income guidelines as dictated by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. This fund was established as a result of the Education Improvement Tax Credit program established by the Commonwealth.

Instructions and Guidelines

- In all cases, financial aid is granted on a one-year basis. Students awarded financial aid must reapply every year to be considered.
- The admission process for incoming freshman needs to be completed (i.e. Admission application on file, entrance exam taken, etc.).
- A financial aid application must also be submitted for financial aid from the Diocese of Erie.
- This application should be filled out by the parent(s) of the student(s) attending Villa and/or Prep. If the parents are divorced or separated, then the parent having financial responsibility of the children should fill out the form.
- Answers all questions. If the information requested is not applicable then enter none or N/A. Do not leave the item blank.
- Incomplete and/or late financial aid forms will likely result in being denied financial aid.
